We want to thank you for your dedication to recycling! In addition to your regular curbside recycling cart where materials can be machine separated; materials collected by RecyclePlus use source separation to meet the acceptance guidelines set by each specialty processor.

Please review the accepted item lists and follow material preparation instructions. All materials must be empty, clean, and dry.



STYROFOAM

White block expanded polystyrene, #6 recycling symbol.

NO: Small broken pieces
NO: Packing peanuts
NO: Wet or dirty Styrofoam
NO: Urethane "soft foam"
NO: Food containers, clean or dirty



TEXTILES

Clothing, shoes, bedding, & fabric scraps.

NO: Items that are wet, mildewed, or contain hazardous materials like oil or gasoline.



LIGHT BULBS


Used and spent incandescent, halogen, CFL, & LED lightbulbs.

NO: Broken light bulbs

Wish-cycling: Including non-recyclable or items with unclear recyclability in the recycling bin with the hope they will be recycled. *A well-intended* assumption that the system will detect and remove any trash down the line.

Wish-cycling is a main contributor of contamination which slows the recycling process, damages equipment, and compromises recycled products' integrity.

When in doubt, find out or throw it out!



Single-use and rechargeable household batteries, A's, C's, D's, & 9V, & button batteries. NO: Car batteries

Improper battery disposal is a leading cause of vehicle fires in the waste industry. For safe battery recycling, please follow these instructions.

BATTERIES

The following batteries require tape.

- Lithium Batteries
- Button/Coin Cell
- Small Sealed Lead Acid (SSLA/Pb)
 Pb
- Rechargeable Greater than 9V. (Ni-Cd, Ni-MH, & Ni-Zn)
- Alkaline & Carbon Zinc Greater than 12V.

✓ Do not cover chemistry label.

✓ Only the positive (+) terminal needs to be taped.

✓ Place large specialty batteries such as cellphones, battery packs, etc. in a *clear* bag such as Ziploc or produce bag. Only one battery per bag.

Separate damaged or leaking batteries.

(Place together in a plastic bag for easy identification. These require separate special handling.)



Plastic Clamshells

#6 recycling symbol (PET or PETE)

NO: Food soiled or wet clamshells, must be clean and dry.

Tips for RecyclePlus

• Store your box where it is protected from rain to avoid moisture and mildew on fabric bags.

Accepted Non-Conductive Tape

Clear Packing tape

Electrical tape

Masking tape

• Painter's tape

Scotch tape

• Duct tape

NOT Accepted

- Bags are not expected to all fit within the box once full. Place over-full bags outside your box.
- Challenge your household to declutter by donating/recycling at least one textile item each time you get a pickup.
- Post these guidelines in a communal space for easy reference, like your fridge.



DO NOT INCLUDE THESE ITEMS: 0

No bags, film, or wrap labeled with #1 (PET), #3 (PVC), #5 (PP), #6 (PS) or #7 (Other).

- K Vinyl shower curtains or tablecloths
- * Bedding or linen packaging

- Degradable/compostable bags or film packaging
